(Postgraduate program in Nutrition and Metabolism in Cancer – 3rd Phase)

Postgraduate program in Nutrition and Metabolism in Cancer created in Dispatch NR/C/0277/2023, by 19th June 2023, by Universidade Católica Portuguesa, governed by the article 111º and by the other rules contained in the Regulation of the Study Cycles of Católica Medical School by Universidade Católica Portuguesa, approved in Dispatch NR/REG/0244/2023, of 23rd May 2023.

1. Conditions for admission of applicants

This postgraduate program is aimed at health professionals, namely doctors, nurses, nutritionists, pharmacists, psychologists, physical activity professionals, and physiotherapists. Applicants with a degree in the professional areas mentioned will be considered. Professionals with an academic and/or research career and researchers in basic science will also be considered.

2. Number of Vacancies:

There are **twenty-one (21)** vacancies available for the Postgraduate program in Nutrition and Metabolism in Cancer.

3. Deadlines

4. Necessary documentation

During the application process, all applicants must complete an online form and attach the requested documents:

- Passport-type photo;
- Identification document Citizen Card or, if other type of document, the tax identification number is also required;
- Academic Degree Certificate(s);

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae;
- Motivation letter (maximum 2 pages).

5. Submission of the application

The application to the Postgraduate program in Nutrition and Metabolism in Cancer is presented exclusively through an online system, on the website of <u>Católica Médical School</u>.

After filling the form, uploading the documents, and submitting, the applicant will have access to the online application platform to pay the application fee. The application will only be completed once payment has been made.

6. Assessment of Applications and publication of results

The selection and ranking of applicants will be carried out by the jury, which is made up of the program Coordinators:

- Professor António Medina de Almeida, Dean of Católica Medical School;
- **Professor Paula Cristina Ravasco,** Coordinator of the Postgraduate program in Nutrition and Metabolism in Cancer.

The application grade will be a weighted average of the assessment of the following criteria:

| Criterion (expressed on a scale from 0 to 20) | Weighting |
|---|-----------|
| Academic training | 50% |
| Profissional Experience | 40% |
| Motivation | 10% |

The applicants will be ranked according to their final classification (on a numerical scale from 0 to 20).

The results will be communicated to applicants in the online application process and will be expressed as follows: Admitted / Not Admitted / Excluded. The anonymized final ranking list can be consulted in the online application process.

7. Operation

The Postgraduate program in Nutrition and Metabolism in Cancer lasts 190 hours (30 ECTS), working in an after-work regime and in *blended learning* format. Classes usually take place on Fridays, between 5 p.m. and 8 p.m. (Lisbon time), and on Saturdays, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. (Lisbon time). The assessment tests take place during the time set for classes. Preferably, the language of teaching is Portuguese, however some classes will be taught in English.

8. Tuition fees, payments and other fees

The value of tuition fees, payments and other fees are determined annually, and published in a separate document (*Tabela de propinas, taxas e emolumentos*), therefore, the values for subsequent school years may change.

The updated values can be consulted on the <u>Católica Médical School website</u>.

The application fee is non-refundable in the event of cancellation, withdrawal, or exclusion of the application.
