**Integrated Master in Medicine**  
**Change of Institution/Course Pair Regime – 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase**

The Integrated Master in Medicine arises from Decree-Law no. 74/2006 of 24<sup>th</sup> March, altered and republished by Decree-Laws no. 230/2009 of 14<sup>th</sup> September, no. 115/2013 of 7<sup>th</sup> August, no. 63/2016 of 13<sup>th</sup> September and no. 65/2018 of 16<sup>th</sup> August, and of Decree-Law no. 42/2005 of 22<sup>nd</sup> February, governed by the principles of the Regulation of Study Cycles of the Católica Medical School, approved by Order NR/REG/0244/2023 of 25<sup>th</sup> May 2023, and by the other conditions contained in this Public Notice.

The Change of Institution/Course Pair regime is governed by Ordinance 181-D/2015 and by the Regulation for Access to the Undergraduate and Integrated Master Study Cycles of Universidade Católica Portuguesa, approved by Order NR/R/0208/2023 of 9<sup>th</sup> May 2023.

**1. Conditions for admission of applicants**

▪ **Applicants Holding Portuguese Secondary Education Diplomas**

Applicants may apply if, by the end of the admissions period and **by the deadline for submitting documents and final grades**, they meet all the following conditions:

- a) The Applicant holds a Portuguese secondary education diploma;
- b) The Applicant was enrolled and registered in another 1<sup>st</sup> cycle institution/course pair, and did not complete it;
- c) The Applicant completed the entrance exams, in any year, having obtained, in each of these exams, a score of at least 140 points (0 to 200), namely:
  - i. 02 - Biology and Geology  
and
  - ii. 07 - Physics and Chemistry  
and
  - iii. 16 – Mathematics;
- d) The Applicant meets the prerequisites established for admission to the degree program, namely:
  - i. Selection:
    - Minimum English proficiency score: European Common Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), level B2;
    - Group A – Interpersonal Communication;
  - ii. Ranking:



- Motivation letter / Portfolio;
  - Mini Multiple Interviews;
- e) The Applicant obtained an application score that is equal or greater than 140 points (out of 200).

▪ **Applicants Holding Foreign Secondary Education Diplomas**

Applicants may also apply if, by the end of the admissions period, **by the deadline for submitting documents and final grades**, they meet all the following conditions:

- a) The Applicant holds a foreign secondary education diploma, obtained abroad or in Portugal, which is legally equivalent to Portuguese secondary education;
- b) The Applicant was enrolled and registered in another 1<sup>st</sup> cycle institution/course pair, and did not complete it;
- c) The Applicant completed, in any year, the final exams of the final year subjects of the respective foreign secondary education degree, equivalent to subjects in Portuguese education, which can be accepted instead of entrance exams, having furthermore obtained, in each of these, a score of at least 140 points (0 to 200), namely:
  - i. Biology  
and
  - ii. Physics and Chemistry  
and
  - iii. Mathematics;
- d) The Applicant meets the prerequisites established for admission to the degree program, namely:
  - i. Selection:
    - Minimum English proficiency score: European Common Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), level B2;
    - Group A – Interpersonal Communication;
  - ii. Ranking:
    - Motivation letter / Portfolio;
    - Mini Multiple Interviews;
- f) The Applicant obtained an application score that is equal or greater than 140 points (out of 200).

**NOTE: This Notice does not exempt you from reading and accepting the Regulation for Access and Admission to the Integrated Master in Medicine at the Católica Medical School, except Articles 3, 4 and 16.**

**2. Number of Vacancies:**

There are **two (2)** available vacancies for the Change of Institution/Course Pair regime.



### 3. Deadlines

**Note:** The last day of applications and registrations corresponds to the deadline of the respective payments.

### 4. Necessary documentation

The necessary documentation is as follows:

- Passport-type photo;
- Identification document – Citizen Card or, if other type of document, the tax identification number is also required;
- Qualifications certificate, if the Applicant holds a Portuguese secondary education diploma;
- Certificate/diploma of foreign secondary education (obtained abroad or in Portugal), legally equivalent to the Portuguese Diploma. Applicants will need to request an equivalence certificate at the Direção Geral de Educação (DGE), if they hold a foreign secondary education diploma;
- ENES Form, issued in the same year as the application, if the Applicant holds a Portuguese secondary education diploma;
- Proof of completion of foreign final exams or final year subject exams of the respective foreign secondary education degree, legally equivalent to the subjects in Portuguese education, if the Applicants holds a foreign secondary education diploma;
- Certificate of the curricular units completed in higher education (Portuguese or foreign) in which the Applicant was approved, with the respective grades, ECTS credits or workload and, for students who have attended foreign higher education institutions, a statement explaining the grading scale, if it is different from the Portuguese system;
- Program of the curricular units in which the Applicant was approved, for the purpose of granting potential creditations;
- Creditation plan for curricular units completed in the higher education course of origin, if applicable;



**Notes:**

- The prerequisites are compulsory and eliminatory, intended for the selection and ranking of applicants, and are only valid for the academic year for which the student is applying. Failure to carry out the ranking prerequisites will result in exclusion from the stage of the competition you are in.
- In order to fulfill the requirements for the Physics and Chemistry entrance exams, applicants must have taken both corresponding exams, and the grade will be the average of the two exams.
- Original documents/certificates are not required during the application; however, it is compulsory to present, face-to-face, all original documents submitted in the application process.
- Original documents issued abroad in accordance with the legislation of the respective country, and documents issued outside Portugal legalized by a foreign civil servant, are considered legalized under Portuguese Law if the signature of the public servant is certified by a Portuguese diplomatic agent or consular officer in the respective State and the signature of that agent is authenticated with the respective consular seal. In the case of documents issued by signatories of the Hague convention of 5th October 1961, the documents will be legalized by apostille, under the terms of article 3 of the convention.
- Documents are only accepted if they are in Portuguese or English. Documents in other languages must be presented as an official translation in English or Portuguese, duly certified and issued within the terms of notarial law.
- Applicants under this regime are not eligible for international student status.

**5. Submission of the application**

The application to the Integrated Master in Medicine degree program of the Católica Medical School is submitted exclusively via the online system, on the website: <https://fm.ucp.pt/integrated-master-medicine/applications?change-language=1>

**6. Assessment of applications and publication of results**

The selection and ranking of applicants will be performed by the selected jury, composed of the Dean of the Católica Medical School, Professor António Medina de Almeida, and of the members of the **Admissions Assessment Committee**.

The application grade will be a weighted average of the assessment of the following criteria:

Criterion (expressed on a scale from 0 to 200)	Weighting
ECTS completed by area in the higher education course of origin*	60%
Average of the grades of the curricular units completed in the higher education course of origin	10%
Secondary education average grade	10%
Entrance exams average grade	5%



Grade of the ranking prerequisites	15%

\*The score of the ECTS completed in the higher education course of origin will be evaluated according to the values defined in the following table.

The results will be communicated to applicants in the online application process and will be expressed as follows: Admitted / Not Admitted / Excluded. The anonymized final ranking list can be consulted in the online application process.

## 7. Operation

The Integrated Master in Medicine has a duration of 6 years (360 ECTS). Classes are usually taught from Monday to Friday, from 8:30 to 19:00. Assessments usually take place during the same hours as classes. The program is taught in English. The Integrated Master in Medicine involves teaching activities inside and outside of the classroom, and specific software is actively used. As a result, students are expected to own a laptop computer to ensure that they can complete all learning activities without limitations.

## 8. Tuition fees, payments and other fees

The value of tuition fees, payments and other fees are determined annually, and published in a separate document (*Tabela de propinas, taxas e emolumentos*), so these values may be subject to change in subsequent academic years.

The application fee is non-refundable in situations of cancellation, withdrawal, or exclusion of the application.

The registration requires payment of the respective fee (which includes student insurance), as well as the first three (3) monthly tuition fees, as indicated in the *Tabela de propinas, taxas e emolumentos*.



In cases of cancellation of registration **until 01<sup>st</sup> September 2026**, the second and third monthly tuition fees will be refunded. The annual registration fee and the first monthly tuition fee are not refundable in cases of cancellation of registration, even if requested within the established deadline.

## 9. Registration

Registration information will be sent to admitted applicants after the results have been published. To complete the registration, the payment of the annual registration fee and the first three (3) monthly tuition fees will be required, as well as the submission of the online enrollment form, including information requested by the Ministry of Science, Technology, and Higher Education (RAIDES survey).

If the applicant does not register within the established deadline, their application will be considered to be withdrawn.

The original documents submitted during the application process must be presented **until 10<sup>th</sup> September 2026**, under penalty of cancellation of enrollment, and without any refund for payments made until that date. The submitted documents must be original or authenticated copies. For the purpose of archiving the student's individual record, the Academic Services may make a copy of the original document, which will be returned to the student, without any additional costs.

## 10. Creditation of previous training or education

After admission, students may request the creditation for previously completed training or education. When requested, the creditation will be processed according to the Regulation of Creditations at Universidade Católica Portuguesa, approved by Order NR/C/0332/2019 of 24<sup>th</sup> October 2019, and the appropriate fees will be applied.
