Training Course in Entrepreneurship in Health

The Dean of the Católica Medical School announces the opening of applications for the 2025/2026 academic year for the Training Course in Entrepreneurship in Health (4 ECTS).

1. Conditions for admission of candidates

The Training Course in Entrepreneurship in Health is aimed at students and lecturers at the Universidade Católica Portuguesa.

2. Number of Vacancies

Candidates will be accepted in the order in which they apply until all (20) places have been filled, provided that the conditions set out in point 1 are met and the application process referred to in point 4 has been completed.

3. Enrolment period | Publication of results | Start of course

Registration will remain open until 15th May 2026, with results published on 01st June 2026. The Training Course in Entrepreneurship in Health will take place from 22nd June 2026 to 17th July 2026.

4. Required documentation

As part of the application process, all applicants must send an email expressing their intention to apply, attaching all the required documents:

- Photograph (passport type);
- Identification document- Citizen card. If another type of identification document is presented, proof of Tax Identification Number must also be submitted;
- Academic Qualifications Certificate;
- *Curriculum Vitae*.

5. Submission of the application

Applications should be submitted by email to medicina.fm@ucp.pt.

6. Admission results

Candidates will be accepted in the order in which they apply until all places are filled, provided that the conditions set out in point 1 are met and the application process referred to in point 4 has been completed. The **admission results** will be published on a digital platform with restricted access to candidates, who will receive their credentials and access link by email, shortly before the results are published.

The results will be expressed as follows: “**Admitted**” or “**Not Admitted**”.

7. Operation

The classes will be face-to-face, held in the evenings, and taught in English.
