(Postgraduate program in Sleep Medicine)

The Post-Graduation Program in Sleep Medicine created in Dispatch NR/C/0404/2022, of 17th November 2022, by the Universidade Católica Portuguesa It is governed by article 111º and by the other rules contained in the Regulation of the Study Cycles of the Católica Medical School by the Universidade Católica Portuguesa, approved in Order NR/REG/0244/2023, of 23rd May 2023.

1. Conditions for admission of applicants

This Postgraduate program in Sleep Medicine is aimed at professionals who already work or intend to start working in the area of sleep, namely, doctors, dentists, technicians, nurses, psychologists, and sleep scientists/researchers. Applicants with a basic degree in professional areas and applicants whose academic curriculum can justify their acceptance will be considered.

2. Number of Vacancies:

There are **20** vacancies available for the Postgraduate program in Sleep Medicine.

3. Deadlines

Applications (online)	From February 28 th (from 9:00 am) to June 13 rd 2025 (until 11:59 pm)
Interviews (online)	From 17 th to 20 th June 2025
Results (online)	25 th June 2025
Registration (online)	From 25 th June to 4 th July 2025
First Day of Classes (presential)	17 th October 2025

Note: The last day of applications and registrations coincides with the deadline of the respective payments.

4. Necessary documentation

During the application process, all applicants must complete an online form and attach the requested documents:

- Passport-type photo;
- Identification document Citizen Card or, if other type of document, the tax identification number is also required;

- Academic Degree Certificate(s);
- Detailed Curriculum Vitae;
- Motivation letter (maximum 2 pages).

5. Submission of the application

The application for the Postgraduate program in Sleep Medicine is submitted exclusively through an *online* system, on the website of the Católica Médical School.

After filling the form, uploading the documents, and submitting, the applicant will have access to the online application platform to pay the application fee. The application will only be completed once payment has been made.

6. Assessment of applications and publication of results

The selection and ranking of applicants will be carried out by the jury, which is made up of the Program Coordinators:

- Professor António Medina de Almeida, Dean of Católica Medical School;
- Professor Amélia Maria dos Santos Feliciano, Coordinator of the Postgraduate program in Sleep Medicine:
- **Professor Susana Isabel Falardo Ramos**, Coordinator of the Postgraduate program in Sleep Medicine;
- **Dr. Andreia Marisa Neves Cardoso Correia Nunes**, Coordinator of the Postgraduate program in Sleep Medicine.

The application grade will be a weighted average of the assessment of the following criteria:

Criterion (expressed on a scale from 0 to 20)	Weighting
Education	50%
Work Experience	50%

The applicants will be ranked according to their final classification (on a numerical scale from 0 to 20).

The results will be communicated to applicants in the online application process and will be expressed as follows: Admitted / Not Admitted / Excluded. The anonymized final ranking list can be consulted in the online application process.

7. Operation

The Postgraduate program in Sleep Medicine lasts 220 hours (30 ECTS). Classes take place mostly on Friday afternoons from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. (Lisbon time) and on one Saturday a month from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. (Lisbon time). Exceptionally, in November there will be a full-day Saturday from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. (Lisbon time). Classes work in a blended learning format.

Lectures will be held online. After each theoretical module, there will be practical classes which will mostly be face-to-face, except for international speakers and students abroad or unable to attend. Naturally, some practical classes and the final seminar will be more profitable if they are face-to-face, but they can also be online.





8. Tuition fees, payments and other fees

The value of tuition fees, payments and other fees are determined annually, and published in a separate document (*Tabela de propinas, taxas e emolumentos*), therefore, the values for subsequent school years may change.

The updated values can be consulted on the <u>Católica Medical School website</u>.

The application fee is non-refundable in situations of cancellation, withdrawal or exclusion of the application.

9. Registration

Enrollment of applicants admitted to attend the Postgraduate program takes place once the tuition fee has been paid.

This Postgraduate program runs from October 2025 to December 2026 and has 220 contact hours.
